School records for the year 1842 were transcribed and published in Volume 1 of The Nauvoo Journal. This article continues with some records for the year 1843. Allen and Leonard in *Story of the Latter-day Saints* (p.158) say that at least eighty men and women were teachers in Nauvoo. Hancock County school records mention twenty-seven teachers in Nauvoo between the years of 1842 and 1845 (George W. Givens, *In Old Nauvoo*, p. 240).
