### Mormon History Association Seeks Presenters

The Mormon History Association has issued an invitation for papers to be presented at its annual conference, scheduled at Kirtland, Ohio, May 22-25, 2003. "Varieties of Mormon Experience in a Pluralistic World" will be the conference theme, with presentations highlighting the unity and diversity that has characterized the Mormon movement from its early days in the 1830s to the present. The complex ways in which Mormonism has interacted with other religious groups in the larger world is a related theme.
