The WICKSON families were in La Salle and Fulton County, IL during the period when the Saints were in Nauvoo. Were they also in Nauvoo? He is found in the 1840 US Census of Detroit Twp, Pike County. His sister Martha died in Utah. Both the BALDWIN and the SWEAT families moved to Knox/Peoria County, IL.

was baptized January 1833 according to Early LDS Church files. Where was he baptized? Sybil Pulsipher PRINDLE, daughter of John and Elizabeth PULSIPHER, born 29 March 1793, was also in Nauvoo. Who was her husband, did she have children, when did she die? Some of the PRINDLE family went with Strang to Beaver Island.

William REED of Frampton, Lincolnshire, England was married on 25 June 1833 at Sutterton, Lincolnshire, England to Rebecca WILLSON. A newspaper article honoring Rebecca upon reaching one hundred years old quotes her as saying that her husband, William, left her to join the Mormons in Utah. Looking for any information on William.

William McMILLEN was born 1820 in Londonderry, Ireland. He joined the LDS Church in Glasgow, Scotland in 1840. In 1842 he married Sarah BELL in Glasgow. He arrived in New Orleans in 1843, then sailed up river to Nauvoo. There he took on the name of THOMPSON after being sealed to Robert Blashell THOMPSON and Mercy Rachel FIELDING. He arrived in Salt Lake in 1848. Who were his real parents and family? Was he really adopted legally into the THOMPSON family, or was it a "Mormon" adoption as was common at the time?

Susanna Dutson BURRUP/BARRUP/BARUPP/BIRRUP/BIRUP, born 1780 in Suckley, Worcestershire, England to Daniel and Ann Pritchard DUSON/DUTSON. She married Edward BURROP in 1798. As a widow, she was converted by Wilford Woodruff and baptised on 6 May 1840. Accompanied by her young grandson, James

BURRUP, and her son-in-law, John Hyrum GREEN and his family to Nauvoo about 1841. Susanna settled in the Camp Creek Branch, some fifteen miles east of Nauvoo, with her son's brother-in-law, Edward PHILLIPS and his mother, Mary Presdee PHILLIPS. Nothing further is known about Susanna. When and where did she die?

Edmund WATTIS, a native of Powick, Worcestershire, England, born 1799 to James and Mary Badham WATTIS. Married Sarah TWINBERROW in 1821. Baptized by Wilford Woodruff on 26 April 1840. He and his second wife, Hannah COMPTON, and children came to Nauvoo about 1842. He then returned to England in 1843 and brought his daughter, Mary Twinberrow Wattis BENNETT and her two young children to Nauvoo. An Edmond WATERS, aged 50, died in Nauvoo of a fever during the week ending 9 September 1844. Is this entry in the *Nauvoo Neighbor* really for Edmund WATTIS?
